Objective of the Symposium: To document and showcase best practices in social development, and to stimulate and strengthen national dialogue on successful strategies in tackling critical development issues.

Practitioners are invited to submit abstracts, whether in written format <u>OR</u> as an audio-visual item, to illustrate best practices utilised in local (Jamaican) initiatives for positive outcomes in the following themes:

- Safety & Security
- Livelihoods
- Family/Parenting
- Governance at the Community Level
- Physical Transformation Housing & Utilities

Individuals whose abstracts are accepted will be asked to develop a full paper/item to be presented at the Symposium. Please note that any overseas-based presenters will be responsible for their own travel costs.

Deadline for submission of Abstracts: 5:00pm on July 30, 2018

Guidelines

Written abstract:

- Submit 1 electronic copy via email of the Abstract, of 300-500 words, and no longer than two typed pages, double-spaced.
- Outline:
 - o Title of Abstract & Name of Author
 - Objective of Intervention
 - Methodology (clearly stating best practice being illustrated, beneficiary participation, etc)
 - Results/Impact
 - Conclusions

Audio-Visual Item

• Submit 1 electronic copy of the item, maximum 3 minutes long, that includes creator's name/organisation, contact information and the title of the item.

- It is important that the audio-visual item is in a format that can be played on any laptop. Upload videos in MP4 or MOV format. Videos should not use special codecs (coders/decoders) in order to provide as much portability across platforms as possible. Any other extensions will be blocked. The video contributions should not have any commercial pitch and the authors of each video must have clear copyright of the visual and audio content.
- Item must clearly show the best practice being illustrated, including objectives, what was done, and the result. Please note that items submitted are **short videos** (live action or animated) not Prezi or PowerPoint presentations.
